THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Northern Ponca Tribe hereby designates the Northern Ponca Housing Resident Association as a Community Based Development Organization pursuant to 24 CFR §1003.204(c)(2)(iv) for purposes of undertaking community development activities in the service area of the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska.

WHEREAS: Pursuant to the Constitution of the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska, the Ponca Tribal Council exercises legislative powers to enact and promulgate resolutions and ordinances subject to all express restrictions upon such power contained in the Constitution; and

WHEREAS: the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska has designated the Northern Ponca Housing Authority as its Tribally Designated Housing Entity, with the authority to administer and participate in housing programs for the benefit of the Ponca Tribe and its members, pursuant to the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996 (25 U.S.C. 4101); and

WHEREAS: the Tribal Council of the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska desires to have an application for an Indian Community Development Block Grant for Fiscal Year 2018 prepared and submitted on behalf of the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska for housing activities.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska hereby delegates the Northern Ponca Housing Authority the sole authority to prepare and submit on behalf of the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska and Indian Community Development Block Grant application for Fiscal Year 2018; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska hereby delegates the Northern Ponca Housing Authority the authority to administer and manage said Indian Community Development Block Grant for Fiscal Year 2018; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska hereby certifies that all Citizen Participation requirements regarding the Indian Community Development Block Grant application have been met according to 24 CFR 1003.604.

APPROVAL TO UTILIZE IHBG FUNDS AS LEVERAGE FOR 2018 INDIAN COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (ICDBG) PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska has designated the Northern Ponca Housing Authority (NPHA) as its Tribally Designated Housing Entity by Tribal Council Resolution No. 97-67; and

WHEREAS, tribes and tribal organizations are eligible recipients of funding made available to improve the nation's housing for Native American people from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) through its Indian Community Development Block Grant (ICDBG) Program; and

WHEREAS, the NPHA has been authorized by the Tribal Council of the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska and the Bureau of Indian Affairs to apply for an ICDBG as a Tribal Organization and Tribally Designated Housing Entity; and

WHEREAS, the NPHA Board of Commissioners has identified the need for land acquisition and new construction activities and has selected the ICDBG as the best program for moving forward with future development planning activities; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of NPHA, as appointed by the Tribal Council of the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska, is submitting a 2018 ICDBG proposal requesting \$800,000 for land acquisition and new housing construction activities; and

WHEREAS, the NPHA Board of Commissioners has identified \$200,000 in future Indian Housing Block Grant (IHBG) funds to be utilized as leverage in its 2018 ICDBG land acquisition and new housing construction activities project; and

WHEREAS, the NPHA Board of Commissioners certifies that the NPHA will continue to be responsible for the ongoing maintenance of the future new housing construction units according to its operations and maintenance policy, and will secure assurances from tenants that they will complete light maintenance and upkeep as specified in individual Lease Agreements; and assures that all new construction activities will be constructed within two years of site purchase; and

WHEREAS, the NPHA Board of Commissioners certifies that the NPHA has adopted Housing Standards as specified in Section III.C.2.b of the 2018 ICDBG NOFA; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of the Northern Ponca Housing Authority has reviewed and understands the requirements of the ICDBG program and authorizes the NPHA Executive Director to prepare and submit an ICDBG application for FY 2018; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Northern Ponca Housing Authority Board of Commissioners is authorizing the use of a total of \$200,000 in Indian Housing Block Grant (IHBG) funds, spread over five years (\$40,000 each year from FY 2019 through FY 2023), to be utilized as leverage for the ICDBG project to acquire land and begin new housing construction activities for low and moderate income families and tribal elders.
