WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska is a federally recognized Indian Tribe (P.L. 101-484) whose business affairs are conducted by the Ponca Tribal Council as defined in the Constitution approved July 22, 1994 by the Acting Deputy Commissioner of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS: Pursuant to the Constitution of the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska, the Ponca Tribal Council exercises legislative powers to enact and promulgate resolutions and ordinances subject to all express restrictions upon such powers contained in the constitution; and

WHEREAS: The Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 was signed in to law on October 30, 2000, placing new emphasis on state and local mitigation planning for natural hazards and requiring communities to adopt a hazard mitigation action plan to be eligible for pre-disaster and post-disaster federal funding for mitigation purposes; and

WHEREAS: A Multi-jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan was prepared by Lower Elkhorn Natural Resources District with assistance from JEO Consulting Group, Inc. of Lincoln, NE, which includes the Ponca Tribe; and

WHEREAS: The purpose of the mitigation plan was to lessen the effects of disasters by increasing the disaster resistance of the District and participating jurisdictions located within the planning boundary by identifying the hazards that affect the District and prioritize mitigation strategies to reduce potential loss of life and property damage from those hazards, and

WHEREAS: FEMA regulations require documentation that the plan has been formally adopted by the governing body of the Ponca Tribe in the form of a resolution and further requesting approval of the plan at the Federal Level.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the governing body of the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska does herewith adopt the Lower Elkhorn Natural Resources District Multi-jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan in its entirety and request approval of the plan at the Federal Level.

WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska is a federally recognized Indian Tribe (P.L. 101-484) whose business affairs are conducted by the Ponca Tribal Council as defined in the Constitution approved July 22, 1994 by the Acting Deputy Commissioner of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS: Pursuant to the Constitution of the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska, the Ponca Tribal Council exercises legislative powers to enact and promulgate resolutions and ordinances subject to all express restrictions upon such powers contained in the constitution; and

WHEREAS: New Mexico Legal Aid is a legal aid organization providing qualifying individuals with free legal services; and

WHEREAS: Legal Aid of Nebraska ("Legal Aid") is a legal aid organization with an extensive history of providing free legal services to qualifying members of the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska; and

WHEREAS: Legal Aid of Nebraska's mission is to promote justice, dignity, hope and self-sufficiency through quality civil legal aid for those who have nowhere else to turn; and

WHEREAS: Legal Aid operates medical-legal partnerships in the Omaha Metropolitan Area that serve hundreds of low-income patients per year, including vulnerable children, adults with disabilities, victims of domestic violence, and the elderly. These medical-legal partnerships are a valuable part of Legal Aid's mission; and

WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribal Council recognizes that collaborative partnerships between legal services programs and healthcare institutions provide low-income patients with means to address critical health-impacting legal needs.

WHEREAS: Legal Aid wishes to join New Mexico Legal Aid and other providers of legal aid to Native Americans in submitting an application on behalf of the Ponca Tribal Council and other Tribes to the Corporation for National and Community Services for an AmeriCorps Indian Tribes Grant in an effort to establish medical legal partnerships with the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska and other providers of health services to Native American in Nebraska, and particularly the Ponca Service Area; and

WHEREAS: In order to submit an application for a grant, Legal Aid must be identified as a "tribal organization" and must be authorized to act on behalf of and include the tribe in a grant application for the purpose of conducting the activities and providing the services described in the application; and

WHEREAS: Legal Aid will assume full responsibility for the fiscal integrity as well as program development and implementation of this application, including full responsibility for any required matching funds.
