RESOLUTION 17-____

WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska is a federally recognized Indian Tribe (P.L. 101-484) whose business affairs are conducted by the Ponca Tribal Council as defined in the Constitution approved July 22, 1994 by the Acting Deputy Commissioner of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS: Pursuant to the Constitution of the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska, the Ponca Tribal Council shall exercise legislative powers to enact and promulgate resolutions and ordinances subject to all express restrictions upon such powers contained in the constitution; and

WHEREAS: The Great Plains Tribal Chairmen's Health Board (GPTCHB) is composed of seventeen (17) Tribes and one (1) Health organization in a four state area; North Dakota, South Dakota, Nebraska, and Iowa; and

WHEREAS: Federally recognized Indian Tribes have an absolute right to health care from the Federal Government, based on treaty rights, on Congressional Acts, on Federal Court decisions, and on the Federal Government's trust responsibility to Indian Tribes; and

WHEREAS: The GPTCHB is primarily responsible for the public health concerns and needs of the Indian Tribes in the Great Plains Area; and

WHEREAS: Reservations in the Great Plains Area experience unacceptably high rates of traumatizing mental distress, depression, risk for suicide and related health problems in adolescents and young adults; and

WHEREAS: Mobile phones are commonly used by Tribal youth as devices for carrying on relationships with peers; and

WHEREAS: These technologies have also shown promise for as means for the delivery of public health interventions to improve mood, reduce levels of distress and lead to an increased sense of well-being; and

WHEREAS: The anticipated benefits of the research project, if funded, may lead to improvements in general health and well-being, greater understanding of the role of peer influences on suicide risk, long-term reductions in suicide attempts/fatalities in study participants, and employment opportunities for tribal members in connection with the project; and

WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska will support recruitment of participants and contribute to the community-based adaptation, implementation, testing, and dissemination of study results of the technology-based suicide prevention model in a timely manner; and

WHEREAS: The Board has delegated the responsibility of the Great Plains Tribal Epidemiology Center to assist Tribes with the identification and development of research agendas, plans, protocols and publications in collaboration with tribal organizations working to improve the health and well-being of Tribal members; and

WHEREAS: The overall purpose of the NIH funding opportunity is to conduct research focused on reducing the burden of suicide and promoting resilience among American Indian and Alaska Native (AI/AN) youth; and
