WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska is a federally recognized Indian Tribe (P.L. 101-484) whose business affairs are conducted by the Ponca Tribal Council as defined in the Constitution approved July 22, 1994 by the Acting Deputy Commissioner of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS: Pursuant to the Constitution of the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska, the Ponca Tribal Council exercises legislative powers to enact and promulgate resolutions and ordinances subject to all express restrictions upon such powers contained in the constitution; and

WHEREAS: On occasion the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska has issued joint resolutions with other tribes in Nebraska on matters of mutual interest; and

WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribe realizes that on issues of mutual interest including lobbying on legislation, a united front of the four (4) tribes in Nebraska can be a more effective way of dealing with various issues that affect all of the tribes or in instances where the other tribes support the position taken by other tribes even if it doesn't affect the Ponca Tribe directly; and

WHEREAS: On July 19, 2017 a historic joint meeting among the Santee Sioux Nation of Nebraska, the Omaha Tribe, the Winnebago Tribe and the Ponca Tribe was held to discuss issues of mutual interest and subsequently passed a joint resolution opposing the Keystone Pipeline which was then read at a recent Public Service Commission hearing; and

WHEREAS: The Tribes that attended the joint meeting thought that meetings among all of the Nebraska tribes should occur on a more regular basis and that a coalition should be formed for such a purpose; and

WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska feels that it would be in the best interest of the Ponca Tribe to participate in a coalition formed by all of the Nebraska tribes to address various issues of mutual concern as addressed above; and

WHEREAS: A document titled "Nebraska Inter-Tribal Coalition, Mission Statement and By-Laws" has been drafted that lay out the basic mission statement and purpose and general structure of the Coalition; and

WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska approves of the mission statement and general structure of the Coalition and the By-Laws and agree that this document is a good way to get the Coalition started and recognize that the document can always be amended.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska Tribal Council hereby approves of the creation of the Nebraska Inter-Tribal Coalition as well as the Mission Statement and By-Laws.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that based on the tribal enrollment of 4017 persons, the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska shall have 140 votes, in accordance with Article III - Members, Section B 1d; and
