ACTION REQUEST:

Motion #1 – Moving of Program Outreach department from IT to Tribal Affairs. There are two employees that this will impact, the Program Outreach Coordinator, employee #1422 and the new Multi-Media Specialist that started on 4/18/22 #TBD. This was an initiative that has been in discussion for at least two years when the prior EDTA was in place and just recently brought up again as the proper place for these positions. There is cross over with Program Outreach in both Tribal Affairs and Health and certainly there will be a dotted line from Outreach to Health and from Outreach to IT.

Motion #2 – We are requesting approval of Multimedia Specialist job description from Information Technology, Grade 5 (\$28,080.00-\$47,424.00) to Position 660, Tribal Affairs, Grade 7 (\$36,441.00-\$55,545.33). This is salary is on the low end for similar positions but acceptable for the level of experience required. Only bringing this forward due to the program move. This can wait for June or be reviewed today since its ready.

Motion #3 – We are requesting approval of Program Outreach Coordinator job description Information Technology, Grade 6, (\$32,552.00-\$51,873.27) to Position 601, Tribal Affairs, Grade 10 (\$51,188.00-\$78,051.24). This salary is on the low end for similar positions but acceptable for the level of experience required. Only bringing this forward due to the program move. This can wait for June or be reviewed today since its ready. The current incumbent of this position, employee #1422 was outside of the previous range (salary \$54,225.60) partially due to the \$3/hr increase. Salary review (if requested by supervisor) will come in June.
